

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: The cost for this tour is \$5035 double occupancy. A non-refundable deposit of \$300 is required from each traveler along with their reservation form to guarantee the booking as soon as possible. The remaining balance is due in 3 payments:

- \$1,900 is due on October 7, 2023.
- The second payment of \$1,900 is due on December 7, 2023.
- The final payment of \$935 is due on February 7, 2024.

For those desiring to room alone, a supplement of \$1335 for single occupancy is due with the final payment.

For those traveling on the land package only, air travel not included, the total is \$3,400 including the \$300 non-refundable deposit. The first payment of \$1,900 is due on October 7, 2023. The second payment of \$1,200 is due on December 7, 2023.

Checks should be made payable to Yosher Tours. If using a credit card, a 3.6 to 4.0% convenience fee will be added to the total.

LUGGAGE (PER PERSON): Checked: one piece of luggage no more than 50 lbs. and total dimensions of no more than 62 inches. Carry-ons: you are allowed to bring one piece that will fit in an overhead compartment (up to 14" w x 22" h x 9" deep) plus a smaller piece that will fit under your seat (up to 10" w x 17" h x 9" deep). In Israel, your luggage will be loaded on the bus when you arrive, transferred to each hotel, and returned to the airport for your departure.

Dr. Galen Peterson is the Executive Director of the American Remnant Mission, the leader of Brit Hadasha Messianic congregation in Concord, California, and professor of intercultural studies for Western Seminary.

Day 1 – Thursday, March 7

Depart from San Francisco in the evening on a direct flight.

Day 2 – Friday, March 8

Arrive at Ben Gurion airport where we will be greeted by our guide who is a Messianic believer. Transfer by bus along the Mediterranean coast to Netanya.

Overnight: Ramada Hotel, Netanya.

Day 3 – Saturday, March 9

Our sightseeing will begin at the ancient seaport of Caesarea, then continue to picturesque Mt. Carmel. At Nazareth, we will take a prayer walk with the White Harvest ministry and visit both of the Churches of the Annunciation. From there, we will enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

Overnight: David's Harp Hotel or Kibbutz Ein Gev Holiday Resort with a private beach.

Day 4 – Sunday, March 10

Our day begins at the scenic overlook of the Sea of Galilee at Mt. Arbel, followed by the sites of Magdala, Capernaum and the Mt of Beatitudes. From there we will go to the headwaters of the Jordan River at the Banias nature reserve and the important New Testament site of Caesarea Philippi. If time permits, we will ascend by bus to Mt. Bental and its impressive panoramic views of the Golan Heights.

Overnight: David's Harp Hotel or Kibbutz Ein Gev

Day 5 – Monday, March 11

We will journey south through the Jordan River valley to Qaser El Yahud, the baptismal site of Yeshua (Jesus), where we will have an opportunity to participate in baptism. Afterward we will visit the site of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, followed by a cable car ride to the top of the Herodian fortress of Masada. This day will also provide an opportunity for swimming in the Dead Sea.

Overnight: David Resort, Dead Sea

Day 6 – Tuesday, March 12

We will travel to the archaeological site of Susya in the Judean hills where we will see the first use anywhere of the name of Yeshua in the mosaic floor at the ancient synagogue. From there, we will continue to make our way south to the Timna Park to see the life-size replica of the biblical tabernacle, then on to Eilat.

Overnight: Astral Village, Eilat

Day 7 – Wednesday, March 13

On this day you will be able to participate in optional activities, including swimming or snorkeling in the warm waters of the Red Sea, seeing the bottle-nosed dolphins, or relaxing on the beach. Some options may entail additional cost. We will also visit the Shelter Hostel messianic ministry.

Overnight: Astral Village, Eilat

Day 8 – Thursday, March 14

In the morning, we will cross into Jordan and transfer to a Jordanian bus and guide. Then, we will travel to the incredible site of Petra. After exploring this ancient city carved into the rocks, we will return to Eilat.

Overnight: Astral Village, Eilat

Day 9 – Friday, March 15

Our early departure will take us to Jerusalem, where we will stop at the Mount of Olives, then walk along the Palm Sunday Path to the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations. Afterward, we will continue to the Western Wall inside the Old City and walk to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Saturday, March 16

Our morning will begin at the site of the Upper Room on Mt Zion, followed by a time of worship at the Garden Tomb. Then we will tour the Israel Museum, including the Isaiah scroll at the Shrine of the Book, and the Second Temple model. We will also visit the menorah depicting biblical history across from the

Knesset. If time permits, we will visit the U.S. Embassy.

Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Sunday, March 17

Today we will have the privilege of hands-on participation at the Emek Zurim archaeological sifting site where many discoveries have been made. Then, we will tour the ancient City of David and walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel (bring shoes you can wear in water!). If open, we will walk the Pilgrim's Path that led to the city in biblical times. We will also visit the Southern Steps, which date back to the Second Temple, Robinson's Arch and the stones of fallen Jerusalem.

Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem.

Day 12 – Monday, March 18

Our day begins at the Temple Mount, including the Dome of the Rock and a consideration of the location of the First and Second Temples. Then, we will visit St. Anne's Church, the Pools of Bethesda, Antonia's Fortress, and the Way of the Cross. We will also go to the Temple Institute to see the worship implements prepared for use in temple worship. Then we will walk through the Jewish Quarter and the Cardo, while also leaving time for shopping in the Old City.

Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem.

Day 13 – Tuesday, March 19

On our last day of touring, we will go to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust. Then we will walk a portion of the Emmaus Road. Afterward, we will participate in hands-on ministry at The Joseph Project, which serves all people of the land by providing material resources. We will conclude our time by enjoying a farewell dinner with delicious Middle Eastern food at the Naura restaurant in Abu Ghosh before heading to the airport.

Day 14 – Wednesday, March 20

Our direct flight brings us back home in the morning.
